## THE MISSION FIELD

local jails, practically one in every county

**731,000**

adults and youth are held in our jails

85% MALE

15% FEMALE

**56%** of men have experienced trauma

**98%** of women have experienced trauma



## WHO IS BEHIND BARS?



**68%**

deal with substance abuse



**56%**

grew up in a single-parent home



**14%** were

homeless prior to arrest, for women up to **50%**

## IMPACT ON CHILDREN



**1 IN 28**

children have an incarcerated parent, nearly **50%**

of these are under the age of **10**

### FORCED TO DEAL WITH FEELINGS OF:

- Fear & anxiety
- Disruptive living conditions
- Lack of contact with incarcerated parent
- Shame and stigma
