



# **CM101: Dimensions of Correctional Ministry**

## **Course Description**

This course introduces the two dimensions of Christian correctional ministry, by examining Christian ministry and criminal justice. Topics focus on integrating Biblical truth and criminal justice along with issues and ministry with those who are justice-involved, corrections staff, victims, and their families.

## **Course Objectives**

Upon completion of the course, learners should be able to do the following:

- A. Describe the dimensions and facets of Christian ministry and criminal justice.
- B. Determine a biblically based theology of mission with the incarcerated and ministry program that serve as a personal foundation for theory and praxis.
- C. Identify corrections programming principles: system's approach, criminogenic risks, needs and strengths, evidence-based practices, trauma informed care, gender-responsive strategies.
- D. Develop self-awareness through discovering your spiritual gifts and strengths, and discern your ministry calling.
